- Apprentice Electrician registration is required with TDLR.
- Completion of on-the-job training and classroom instruction (usually through an apprenticeship) is required.
- Postsecondary certificate (like the one at TSTC) is recommended.
- Pass licensing exams to move beyond apprentice level.
